1. Do you subscribe to OPIS or do you require vendor to submit OPIS reports? **We do not subscribe to OPIS, the vendor is to submit the OPIS report.**
2. What is the average size of deliveries per product? **See Addendum #1 addendum, which includes the past years BOL**
3. Do you ever split gasoline/diesel deliveries? If so, how often? **See Addendum #1 attachment. Most deliveries include both, with a few exceptions.**
4. What OPIS terminal is your current vendor using? **Atlanta**
5. What OPIS terminal city would you like us to use for this contract? Atlanta, Macon? **Atlanta**
6. Will the contract extensions be mutually agreed upon? **If you're referring to annual contract extensions, yes of course mutual.**
7. When is the award date? **Once the bids are opened and evaluated, then board of commissioners approved, the award is announced. There is no specific date as it will depend on the Commissioner's meeting schedule.**
8. If we do not attend the bid opening, how and when will we be notified of the low bidder and can we receive a copy of the bid tabulations? **Yes, you can request a copy of the Bid Tabulation. Page 4, section V indicates the Evaluation Criteria. We do not notify individuals but do post the award on Georgia Procurement.**

9. The RFP says to provide a markup to OPIS as the differential. What OPIS market would the county like for us to use? Atlanta, Griffin, Macon? What OPIS market is currently being used by the incumbent? **The County's current fuel provider utilizes the Atlanta OPIS Contract Daily Average as the pricing benchmark for both gasoline and diesel products. For purposes of this solicitation, bidders shall apply their proposed markup or discount to the Atlanta OPIS Contract Daily Average for the applicable fuel products.**
